The wireless network is free to all library patrons. Patrons bring their own wireless-enabled laptop computer or other wireless device to the Library to use the service. The Library does not loan laptops, wireless cards, or PDAs. Wireless Internet is available during regular library business hours.

Library staff cannot disable the filter on non-library computers.

Library personnel are not able to help wireless network customers configure their laptop computers or other equipment. Everyone's computer is different; the Library cannot support customers' equipment configurations.

The Library cannot be responsible for any changes customers make to their hardware or software.

Your information is not protected while using the wireless network. Keep this in mind when accessing sensitive or personal information. All wireless access users should have up-to-date virus protection on their personal laptop computers or wireless devices.

A fully charged battery is recommended. Public electric outlets may not always be available. Patrons may not string electrical cords across areas where people may be walking.
