However, no longer a "small town" library serving a small-town population, Ella Johnson faces demand for increased services and resources to meet the needs of our expanding population. Ella Johnson Library District serves as the home library of nearly 17,000 people across multiple growing population centers, covering an area of 100 square miles. A library modeled for a small population of around 6,000 now struggles to meet the varied needs and expectations of a blossoming and diverse library community.

Additionally, Ella Johnson faces the same challenges as public libraries across the country—a constantly changing landscape for library operations and rapidly evolving information habits among users. In this new environment, libraries serve as a bridge across informational and technological gaps and help people make sense of the world.
